



FACE PAINTER

- **Please provide:** 1 table- 6ft or 8ft preferred, and 2 chairs per artist at your event. Please be sure the artists' area has good lighting. **Picnic tables are not sufficient for their needs.** Parking lot and cell phone lights are not sufficient.
- The client is responsible for any parking fees and will provide reasonably close parking for the artists to park and unload.
- **Entertainer arrives approx. 15 minutes prior to their contracted start time.**
- Our entertainers need to be protected from wind, rain, cold or sun. If not indoors, please provide a tent or other appropriate structure. If needed, CC&E can provide entertainer tents for an additional charge.
- CC&E's policy does not allow our painters to paint with any other painters present due to insurance, product and quality concerns. CC&E reserves the right to refuse service in this situation and payment in full would be due.
- CC&E does not face paint children that are under 2 years old.
- Children with skin allergies for sensitive skin should either not participate, or have the artist perform a patch test at the beginning of the party.
- Artist will use reasonable care, but is not responsible for damage to clothing or property.
- Creative Carnivals' artists will be focused on providing a "one-on-one" experience with your guests. Volunteers are required to maintain line control and to monitor the behavior of your participants. CC&E can supply a line manager upon request for a nominal fee.
- If your event is a fund-raising situation in which tickets or cash are to be collected for entertainer services, a volunteer should be provided to do this for the entertainer. Variables that may affect the number of children painted are: children who are very young, have special needs or behave poorly while being painted, weather conditions or ineffective line management by someone other than the painter. The average pace per hour is 15-20 faces.
- Artist has the right to cease painting and leave without refunding any monies if there are extreme adverse working conditions and the customer fails to remedy the situation after it has been brought to the customer's attention. Adverse conditions include but are not limited to: destructive, violent, or extreme inappropriate behavior of a child, pet or adult; illegal activities; or otherwise dangerous weather conditions such as extreme heat, cold or lightening, and if adequate lighting is not provided for the entire length of the event.
- Limitations on artwork: Artist will not paint on any part of the body that is not legal to expose or any place the artist does not feel comfortable painting. Artist will not paint any design or wording that is obscene, offensive, violent or defies good taste. If there is a specific theme or desired art, the customer must provide that information prior to the event so the artist can bring appropriate designs for the face paint options list.
- **A two-week cancellation or time-change notice is required for all entertainers. An indoor option would need to be provided for any weather related issues. Any cancellation or schedule change occurring with less than the two-week notice will result in the customer being charged the full contract amount. A cancellation prior to two weeks of the event date after the contract has been signed, will result in a \$50 cancellation fee.**
